

## BORS Public Lecture hosted by Cardiff University

On Friday the 27<sup>th</sup> of May, liverymen attended the British Orthopaedic Research Society's (BORS) first hybrid public lecture by Professor Andrew McCaskie from Cambridge University hosted by Cardiff University. The lecture titled "From Steel to Stem Cells: Regenerative Therapies in Orthopaedic Surgery" covered current treatments for osteoarthritis; the use of cell therapies; and the importance of gathering information from translational research to help develop future targeted and evidence-based treatment options prior to joint replacements. This was followed by three showcase presentations from Cardiff University by early career researchers. This included a presentation by our 2021 Gold Development Award Winner Dr David Williams talking about his work on using X-Rays to understand the movement of different parts of the body. The public lecture was hosted as an in-person and simultaneously a Zoom webinar where over 60 people attended, spanning 35 different cities, 8 different countries and 3 different continents, highlighting the truly international nature of this event.
