## **THE SILVER JUBILEE DEVELOPMENT AWARD**

**The Worshipful Livery Company of Wales has announced that for 2021-2022 the topic for this Award of £2,500, is Fine Arts. Applications for this Award are now invited and the closing date is 31 January 2022.**

**Objective of the Award:** To enable an outstanding young person with a commitment to Wales, who has graduated from an academic institution, or qualified with a professional body, to further their academic or professional development by undertaking an innovative self-contained project which will help them build their career in some form of Fine Arts as defined below.

**Age Range:** Young person aged 21 – 25 with possible extension to 30 if the candidate is a postgraduate student. Candidates will be expected also to have shown a commitment to Wales.

**Subject Area: Fine Arts.** Projects to be in one of the following categories only:

- Painting/drawing of all styles.
- Printmaking – including graphic design.
- Sculpture – May include studies relating to working with stone, plaster, wood, ceramics, glassware, silver or other metal work.

**Categories excluded are:** photography, film making, drama, dance, poetry, drama and music.

**The Award:** The Award may not be used to support academic course fees, but may be used to travel to a recognised academic centre to study a particular art process/technique/produce a portfolio of work about a specific topic that applicants would need to further their professional development.

The Award, which has a value of £2,500, is to be spent before the end of 2022, in furtherance of the objectives outlined above on a project which is to be detailed as requested on the application form. In addition, the winner of the Award will receive a Prestigious Award Certificate and an invitation to a significant Livery Company event. Recipients of the Award will also be required to provide a report detailing the use to which the Award funds have been put and the benefits which have resulted to the furtherance of their academic or professional development.
