

Bryan Marsh was a Past Master of our Livery Company, a Liveryman of the Tin Plate alias Wire Workers Livery Company and a great benefactor of our Awards programme.

The 2024-25 winner of the £5000 Award, our most prestigious, to be used to help finance a project is **Dr. Ryan Jones**.

Ryan has a PhD in Biomedical Research and a Master's degree in Biomedical Science, both from Cardiff University. He is currently a research associate at Cardiff University.

Ryan's project is to develop a stem cell derived model of the sensory nerve interface for the study of pain and cancer metastasis, non-healing fractures and osteoarthritis without the need for animal testing. This could benefit many pain sufferers in Wales and beyond and could put Wales on the map for the relief of bone pain, leading to improved treatments and better outcomes for people with bone -derived pain.

Ryan Jones is a very worthy winner of this year's Bryan Marsh Gold Development Award.
